

ORDINANCE NO. 174

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY OF KEOSAUQUA MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE VI  
(PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT), CHAPTER 3 – (UTILITIES – WATER SYSTEM)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KEOSAUQUA, IOWA:

**Section 1.** The City of Keosauqua Municipal Code (the "Code") Title VI, Chapter 3, Section 6, Subsection 19 is hereby amended as follows (Note: provisions deleted from the Code are struck through and provisions added to the Code are underlined):

**6-3-6 (19)** There shall be two (2) classes of permit applications; one for residential service, and the second for commercial and industrial service. In either case, the owner or his agent shall make application. Their permit application shall be supplemented by any plans, specifications, or other information considered pertinent in the judgment of the inspector. A permit and inspection fee will be based upon the size of service required as listed below:

The fee shall be paid to the municipality at the time the permit application is filed. Service lines and appurtenances shall be constructed in accordance with the State Plumbing Code regulations.


**Section 2.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** If any section, provisions, or parts of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
